FOOD BANK: JOINT UPDATE FROM ST HELEN'S/ST JOSEPH'S

The food bank staff are very grateful for the increased donations from both parishes, amounting to 46 bags of various items of food etc and £110 in cash.

The main shortages are still toiletries and petfood. All basic, simple to prepare, non-perishable foodstuffs, including Value brands are always acceptable.

Donations can be left at church or at 39 Ilford Avenue, L23 7YE or 1 Halltine Close, L23 6XX. Cash in envelopes, marked Food Bank, can be posted through either letter box or placed in the weekend plate collections.

CAFOD: St Helen's pray-fast-give

Last year your donations were a part of CAFOD's total income of £47.9m. There was a significant carry over from the previous year to add to that. Thank you. Around 12% of that income was spent in admin and fundraising costs. These would range from cleaning the head office to maintaining the website. International development aid at £23m was the second biggest expenditure but you won't be surprised to hear that this was exceeded by disaster relief funding at £24.7m. Significantly, £6.1m of income was provided by the Disasters Emergency Committee. This is because the DEC recognises that CAFOD, working through local partners in those countries affected by disasters, is able to have immediate and more effective access and impact than other agencies. Your donations of the last two week's, totalling £531, contin-
